[Please Read Catechism of the Catholic Church 199 to 231]

**Summary:** Our faith begins with the fundamental belief in one God, the Father Almighty, who created everything in existence. This God is not an abstract force but a personal being who has revealed Himself to us through His name, YHWH, meaning "I AM WHO AM." He is the source of all truth, love, and life.

God is not only the Creator of the universe but also a loving Father who cares for His creation. He is merciful, gracious, slow to anger, abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness. This love extends to each one of us, made in His image and likeness.

**Reflection:** Imagine God as a loving parent who is always there for you, no matter what. He knows everything about you, even the things you might be ashamed of, and loves you unconditionally. This is the God we believe in, the God who created the amazing world we live in. We can trust Him completely and turn to Him for guidance and strength.

## Questions to Discuss:

What does it mean to you that God is the Creator of everything?

How can we show our love and gratitude to God for His creation and His love? **Bible Verse to Remember: Deuteronomy** 6:4: "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one."
