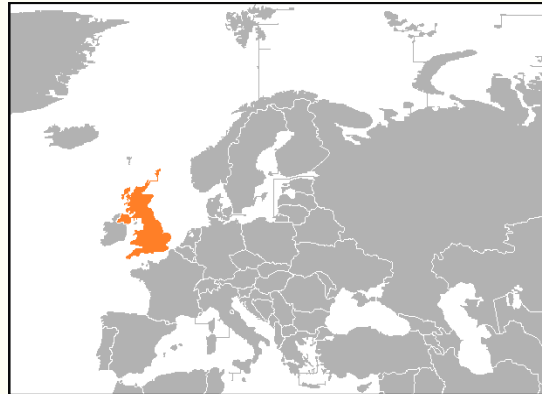

hill		A raised area of land smaller than a mountain.



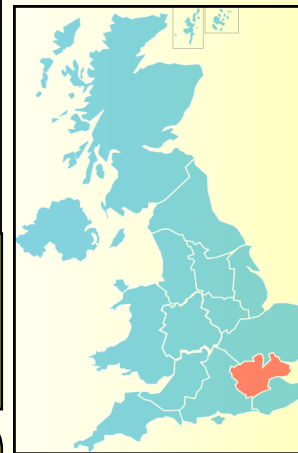
England is part of the United Kingdom (UK). The UK is in Europe.


These are examples of the physical features. They would be here even if there were no people around.
